It was a blessing to have a group of 13 people, mostly students from PCC. They all came with a willingness to learn, help and get involved in our daily activities serving the Lord. After school, we went out soul winning 3 afternoons. The Lord gave us 25 souls. Praise God. As we witnessed, we were also looking for new deaf people, we found 3. Two of them are 9 and 11 years old girls who know no Sign Language and have no communication skills. We offered our help. Lizette the mom of one of the girls, Renata, brought her daughter to our school and shared that she had Renata in other schools since she was 18 months old; she is 11 now and can not even communicate with her mom. We let her experience learning in Sign Language. Renata is so happy and already started learning. Lizette said, “I have not seen my daughter this happy in a long time.” My wife had the joy of leading Lizette to the Lord. We have a wonderful Savior who loves us so much.

Thank you so much for praying and giving. Please continue to do so; there are still many people to reach.
