Pastor and Church Family,

Since we arrived back in the USA in September we have travelled over nine thousand miles and been in many meetings and conferences. It was a busy couple of months and we were able to report to several supporting churches and present to some new ones as well. We will be a little less frantic during the Christmas season, but much of December will be spent scheduling for the New Year.

I have ordered our new prayer cards, and we spent the time making our presentation video that will be completed shortly. Getting prepared for furlough was more intensive than we imagined, but getting straight to work was a blessing. During the missions conferences, Alyssa and I have had the privilege to speak and teach in churches as well as hear from missionary evangelists and have our passion for missions reignited.

With our first furlough underway, the biggest question we have been asked is, "What is next?" And the answer is simple: We plan to apply for our residence permit in Namibia in 2019. Please be in prayer that we will be able to raise the necessary additional support and gain approval from the Namibian government. While we know that our time in South Africa was what the Lord had for our first term, our desire is to minister in Namibia and this next step is one of faith. A permit to Namibia is not easy to obtain.
