We made it to Uganda! Thank you for keeping us in your prayers and faithfully supporting us! The end of deputation came quickly. In October, the Lord took us from Ohio to California, and finally to Washington State. We were in three mission's conferences along the way, and the Lord blessed. The Lord allowed us to finish our deputation with 93.7% of our needed support. Thank the Lord we had safe flights, and we landed in Uganda on the 6th of November with 27 bags. It was a long trip! We were able to settle into a furnished apartment while we started looking for a house. The last two months have been challenging, but we praise the Lord He has allowed us to begin the adjustment process. The Lord blessed, and we have found a house to rent that is close to the church.

We are now looking for a vehicle to purchase that will meet the needs of family and ministry. Thank the Lord Pastor Vincent Ajusi from Luzira Independent Baptist Church is allowing us to borrow his car until we can purchase the right one. Please be praying as we still need to raise the remainder of the funds for our vehicle, which is \$4,000. If you could be one of the ten that would help with an offering of \$400, we would reach the \$4000 very quickly. The funds can be sent to BIMI with vehicle marked in the memo. Thank you for praying with us about this need.

Please keep Jen, the boys and me in your prayers as we adjust to a different culture and life in Uganda. A lot has changed since I left in 2004, but we are excited to see that the people are still the same Ugandans that need the Lord. Since we arrived, Pastor Vincent has given me the opportunity to preach three times, and I enjoy preaching and sharing God's Word with them. Please keep praying for us as we minister and share the Gospel with the lost. We are praying that we can be an encouragement to the church here and help them start up an outreach ministry. I have already talked to Pastor Vincent, and he is excited to be able to have a faithful partner to go soul winning.

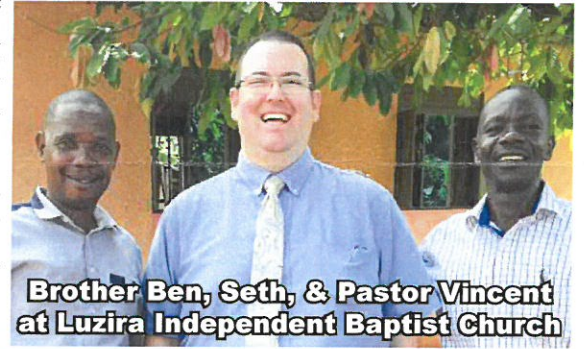

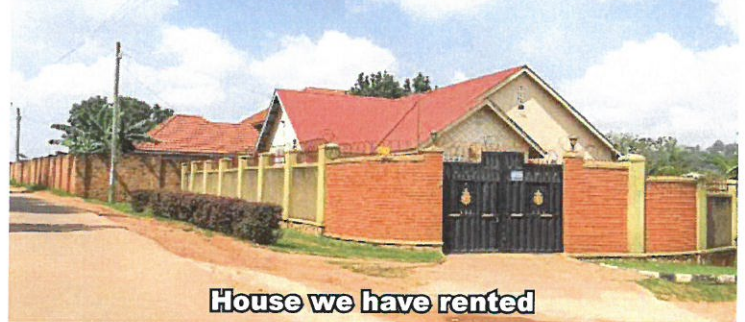
