Trip to Fatu-Makerek

During my previous newsletter I mention the village of Fatu-Makerek and the challenges Christians are going through. Although I have never been there, many of our young people were from there. I was feeling restless listening to stories, so I set a time to visit the place. Last May that plan was realized. No proper road that lead to the place. The village can be reached only by foot or horseback for 10 hours from the place where it is accessible by vehicles. It is difficult to describe what I have seen. According to story, the village used to hide freedom fighters and feed them. In anger the Indonesian military destroyed their crops and relocate them in small hamlets. Unfortunately, the government has forgotten them and no one cares until recently when some of the villagers become Christians they remembered them only to persecute them for their faith.
