Summer youth camp was the first full week of July. I want to thank the Lord for two young men that went to camp this year. They are from the English class I teach on Saturdays. I had the opportunity to share the gospel with one of the young men, Hank. He said that he wants to get saved but he cannot because of family pressure to continue their ancestral worship. In Taiwan's culture, because Hank is the oldest son, it will be his responsibility as he gets older to lead their family in worshipping their ancestors. Please pray for Hank and his family. I visited with his mother, and she said he could come to church. Please pray that we may have wisdom in dealing with situations like these.

At the end of July, we had our first baptism service, where I had the privilege of baptizing four people – a mother (Grace), her son (Samuel), our first convert Amy, and our oldest son Ethan. What a blessing it was to baptize my own child! Please pray for these as they grow in the Lord.

I would like for you to meet Louis. Louis has been coming to our church for months and has been very faithful. He is from Taichung, where we used to live. When he was a teenager, he made a profession of faith; but he told me it was out of pressure from the other young people. A couple of weeks ago, he came to our house for some English help; and during his visit, I felt the Holy Spirit tugging at my heart to talk to him about his soul. Not long after that, he bowed his head and prayed to accept Christ as his Savior. He has been dealing with a lot of depression and going to doctors for medication and help. I shared with him about the peace and joy that only comes through Jesus. I could tell he was tired of trying to handle all of his issues by himself. Please pray for Louis as we begin discipling him.


