Happening now: Since our last letter, I had the privilege of Baptizing five individuals. Just a few weeks ago, we ordained Pastor Amador into the ministry. The Church planting work is steady. We are **holding five services a week, in three different Church plants.**

Thursday, we met visitors from a supporting Church at the airport. I received a request in that same morning to carry members from the Patchakan church to a neighboring village for a prayer service in the home of an individual. Friday, in the morning we had our parade for school age kids, and in the afternoon I officiated at the funeral of a member of our San Victor church who had died suddenly. He was a victim of a **deadly virus which has kept the hospital full of people from our churches. I preached a Gospel message to over 150 people at the funeral.**

Saturday, we spent most of the day hosting some lively visitors from The States. Their choice for afternoon activity was to visit one of the many Mayan Ruins, with temple mounds that are over 100 feet tall. Of course, this Missionary is not going to let the younger ones out-climb him...ohhh my feet. Sundays are always full, with four services in three different towns.

Please pray that we will always be “redeeming the time”, even on the days with no church services. **Pray for those in the new Church plant at San Victor,** for souls saved and spiritual growth. Please pray for our upcoming **trip to The States,** for the missionary who will be filling in for us, as well as for additional **new supporting Churches. We are asking that The Lord supply an additional five supporting Churches,** so that we may continue winning souls and planting Churches here in Belize.
