Dear Friends,

We have 5 independent churches in Reynosa and 4 of them are pastored by graduates of our school in Mante. In 2007 we organized the Bethel Bible Baptist Church and it has the best location of these churches. Despite the terrible things going on in this city by the drug cartel our church pastored by Bro. Jose Antonio Velesquez is being a witness to the city. Four new families have started attending and this is an encouragement to all the members. They had to repair the van that they use to pick up people on Sundays. One of the men in the church did the repairs and this kept the expense down. Pastor Antonio and family have moved into the parsonage which is not finished but is liveable. As the Lord supplies they will need to put tile on the floor. The average attendance for last month was 145 with 8 saved.

We recently received the news that Eddie Hernandez was able to renew his visa for another year. He is a missionary to Irak and grew up in Mante about 3 miles from the Bible Institute. He graduated from there in 1990. Eddie pastored churches in Monterrey and Mexico then God called him to Irak and he and his wife and 3 children have been there for 7 years. The work is slow but growing. They have had some bad times but God has protected them through everything. He is now teaching English classes to be able to contact more people. Most of his work is done one on one. Pray for Sahan, Solin, and Hevar, young people he is visiting and hopes to win to Christ soon. They also need a new meeting place. Please pray for this family.

Hope you like the picture of Hiram and Raquel Guillen. Hiram has been pastor of Calvary Baptist for about 10 years. They have 3 children and God is blessing the church. We learned to love Raquel when she was dean of women for 7 years. They were robbed at gunpoint about 1 year ago but continue to work and have an attendance of 145 People. The church organized recently one of their missions on the west side of town. It is now Victory Baptist Church and their pastor is Luis Rivera and his wife is Elizabeth. Her grandfather was Jose Sanchez and he help start Calvary Baptist. Three of his grandchildren are in the ministry.

The Bible college in Mante opened it's doors to begin classes for a new school year. They had 29 students enrolled. There was a good attendance with more than 50 pastors present. The special speakers were Angel Zapata and Mosies Salazar both graduates of the school.. The messages challenged the people to be faithful in the service of the Lord.
