

Village Church Plant Update



We have seen a good number of our neighbor kids attend our Sunday service. We have also had newer children attend as well. We are encouraged each week to hear the answers to questions from our young people during the lessons. I can see that for some their understanding of the Gospel message is improving and hope that one day soon they will be saved.

Our Chinese friends, Sholi and Katya with their two youngest children drove twice from the city to attend our services. Katya and the kids live during the school year in China. She has taken a great interest in our family and is impressed with our overall Christian family behavior. This has opened up a door to share the Gospel with her. She has begun reading in Chinese the Bible as well as the book, "Done" by Carey Schmidt. Please pray for our continued witness to this family.



Summer Projects

The weather this summer was fantastic. It allowed us to finish early with our yearly projects that are a way of life in the Russian village. Not much can be accomplished outside the house during the long cold winters, so taking advantage of each day during the spring and summer is a must.

This year we had to fix and update our septic system. We had two occasions this past winter where a blockage in the line caused great difficulties with water backing up in our house's sewer pipes. We decided to dig up the line going from the outside septic tank to its connection under our home. It is a good thing that we did. We found that the pipe was crushed because all the pipe was the wrong type in addition to not having been laid properly. We also decided to separate our septic system into a grey and black water system. We now have a separate tank for toilet waste. This should reduce yearly costs on pumping out the septic. Our grey water waste can be used in the yard during the summer months.



Missionary Vehicle Update

On Aug 22, I sent out an email asking you, our supporters, to consider helping us pay off our outstanding loan balance for our 2013 Chevrolet Tahoe 4WD ministry vehicle. Several churches responded to this need and of the \$10,800 balance that was owed \$6,894.81 was received. We only need an additional \$3905.19 to pay off this loan.
