We hope you all are doing well and God is blessing your summer. I'm not sure what the weather is like there with you, but it is a hot summer here in Taiwan.

In our last letter, I wrote about a new missionary family coming to work with us. We want to thank God for bringing new missionaries to Taiwan, and we also want to thank you for praying for them. The end of May they moved to Taiwan and since then they have been getting their home set up and adjusting to life in Taiwan. They begin language study this week. Please continue to pray for Corey, Jessica, and Adeline Kershner.

Also, in May we had our annual ladies meeting. We want to thank you for praying for it. God really blessed us with a great day. This year April asked a friend from Taichung to come and speak. Mrs. Terri Green did a great job speaking to our ladies. We were blessed to see the involvement of our ladies. The work to get things ready, as well as, inviting unsaved friends and family was an encouragement to us.

We want to share with you what God has been doing in the church. Last week we went to youth camp. We thank God for a great week. A total of 125 were in attendance this year. We had three young men go from our church, two of whom do not know Jesus as their Savior. Please pray for Brian and Wesley.

Sunday, July 9, we had our baptismal service. This year I had the privilege to baptize three: Oliver, the young man I wrote about in our last letter; Elisa, whom April led to Jesus last fall; and MayFang. MayFang has been coming to our church for some time and knows she is saved but has never been Scripturally baptized. We thank God for these three following the Lord in baptism. Please pray for them as they grow in Christ.

July 24-30 we will be having our first English day camp. This year we have had 15 sign up for an all day English camp at our church. Because of Ethan attending first grade in a Taiwanese school this year, we have built many relationships with his classmates and their parents. Our goal is to teach the kids English and prepare them for the last day of camp, which is Sunday. We will be inviting the families to attend on Sunday so they can hear what the kids learned during the week. During this service, I will also be sharing the Gospel with them. Please pray for this camp and for the final day Sunday July 30.

Please continue to pray for April and the baby. They both are doing well. Thank you so much for your continued prayers.
