Ministry News

December and January were very busy and productive months. In December I was able to preach for the first time in Hindi. While it was only two minutes (*it felt like twenty to me*) it was exciting to preach the Word in the Hindi language. In our last prayer letter I had requested prayer for a taxi driver, Harish, who had been picking me up daily for language school. At the beginning of January, he left his taxi service to restart his machining business. He responded via text a few times but doesn't seem to be interested in church or the Gospel. We ask you to continue remembering him and his family in prayer. Sunil is a young man who has been around the Grace Baptist church for many years. He was saved and baptized there as a young teenager but had to move back to his village a couple of years ago. He came back to Delhi last year and began attending the Robert's second church plant, Grace Baptist church, in West Patel Nagar. I was recommended to ask Sunil about helping me with my Hindi as well as starting a daily Bible study which would be beneficial for both of us. He agreed to help and I've been encouraged by his friendship and faithfulness. He has a tremendous heart for the Lord and a desire to serve God. He spends most days with Dass and Abhishek, the Indian Pastors in West Patel Nagar, where he does Bible study and assists the church in any way. We meet almost everyday for some Indian food, a good time of fellowship and one or two hours of additional Bible study. It's my prayer that Sunil will give his life to serve the Lord full time in the days to come.

Many express their opinion of who they think will prove to be the most competent leader and which party offers the best solutions to the country's problems.
