Thank the Lord for another year of safety in all of our travels! The Lord certainly was gracious to us. What a wonderful year it was for the Reseeding America Ministry. We were involved in four restarts/jumpstart projects in two states, which resulted in many visitors for the churches involved. Also we were able to present the Reseeding America Ministry in church services, chapel services and mission conferences.

One of our Reseeding America church planters moved to Texas last spring to reopen a church that had been closed for over two years. This work is located in Whitehouse, Texas, which is on the Northeast side of Tyler. They just chartered the church on November 9, 2014, with 72 people attending the Charter Service and three being baptized after the special services!

The Reseeding America church planting survey trip to the Pacific Northwest took place in July. Our group of seven men met with 25 church planters in Washington, Oregon and Idaho during a ten day period. Several of the men who went gave testimonies as we neared the end of our trip that God had worked in their hearts concerning church planting in that needy region of the country.

From the end of August until the first week in November, our focus was on the Northeastern United States as we assisted two of our Reseeding America church planters as they prepared and opened the doors of their churches in Fairfield, Connecticut, and Annapolis, Maryland. Both church plants are doing well as they meet in Public School facilities and minister to their respective communities. It was an encouragement to see the assistance and involvement the sending churches and many sister churches had in the start of these new works as we passed out tens of thousands of Scripture and church info packets. Praise the Lord for the many helpers at the opening services of both new churches.

Early December will find us on the road to North Carolina as we will be assisting one of our Reseeding America Hispanic church planters in the start of a brand new Hispanic work in Mountain Home. One of the exciting aspects of this project is that the church planter has been given a debt free church building in which to start the new work! Please pray for workers and funds in the necessary repairs and updates needed for this church building.

Some of you may remember Jennifer's medical "adventure" last November in Wyoming and Utah. After eight hours in an emergency room in Wyoming with an out of control "racing" heart, she was airlifted by a medical helicopter to Provo, Utah. Following a heart catheterization, she received a heart ablation to repair an unknown, until then, birth defect. Thankfully, the hospital in Wyoming and the Utah based helicopter company were both satisfied with what the insurance paid them. Unfortunately the hospital was not and just sent a bill a week ago. After paying the heart doctors, the remainder of funds given to us by gracious churches were sent to the hospital in Utah. We still owe \$4000 to this facility. Payments have been set up for 30 months, but we are praying that God would enable us to pay this off much faster if it is His Will. Please pray with us concerning this need. Thank you so much to those who helped us with these expenses, you are such a blessing to us!!
