It was a special service indeed. The town witch doctor had gotten saved, and she was giving her testimony in church as well as going to her village that same Sunday morning to tell her family she was now saved! The services were good, but Mrs. Kabina's testimony of salvation made it even better! I definitely wanted to go with the church to hear Mrs. Kabina tell her family she was no longer a witch doctor, but now a child of God. So many people do not respond this way of telling their family their testimony from their own mouth. A lot of people will not even let the church know they have received Jesus for someone else would say, "Yes, such and such is saved, Praise God!" But the person themselves will not even open their mouth. This was not the attitude of Mrs. Kabina. Even while she was in church that Sunday morn, I saw her with a Bible open and listening to the preaching. Again, this is rare too, people with Bibles and also, bringing them to church. ***Pray for Mrs. Kabina's growth in the Lord and faith in His Word for this occupation of being a witch doctor was how she earned income for her family.***

I was asked if I would speak at the Agago District Baptist Church's First Women Conference in Lira 22 Nov. What do you think I said...absolutely YES!!! The distance is not long, but the bad condition of the roads makes it long. This church is a church plant of Pastor Josue of Christ Biblical Baptist Church in Lira. I went with four of his members, and we made it there in good time with no problems on the road! The women were waiting, and I was able to start as soon as I entered the church. There were

about 40 women representing 6 churches there. The person who was translating did a very good job since it was her first time translating, for me. The participation from the women was outstanding! When I speak I do like to get the women involved. We had food and fellowship before we had to leave. Then a few days later the Pastor called and told me how the women enjoyed the meeting. I was very encouraged by his call for it helps me to know that the women understood what I was telling them. They are planning one for next year, too.



ONLY ONE WOMAN IN SERERE PRISON? This is a good thing. I finally made the effort of going to visit Serere Prison to find out if I could visit the women there. I could never get into Soroti Prison where I live so Serere was the next closes prison. The ground of the prison looked outstanding with colorful flowers and nicely painted building. I don't know if they would have let me taken a picture. I talked with the OIC and he had no problem with me visiting the women. He asked me, "When would I like to visit them?" I said Thursdays at 1500. I was glad he spoke good English. He told me there had been three women, but two had been released earlier in the week. I asked if I could speak with the one that was left, he said yes. The woman prisoner was seated not far from where we were talking. It was a blessing that she spoke good English too. I introduced myself and asked her name. Her name is Ruth. I also asked why she was there. She told me she had taken monies that she was asked to keep, but used it for her child's school fees instead. The owner of the monies put in prison for it. She is serving a 6 month stay. She will be getting out in Jan 2017. She does not live far from the prison in which Serere Independent Baptist Church is right near the prison and hopefully she will be able to visit there once she is freed. I talked with her for a while and asked if she had trusted Jesus as her Lord and Saviour. She said yes, and that she read her Bible daily. I told her I will be back to visit her in Dec. I am looking forward to see how God will use me at Serere Prison in the coming New Year. I learned while being there that only short term prisoners are kept in

Serere Prison with a max time being 6 months and those longer than 6 months go to Soroti Prison. ***Pray for someone to be able to accompany me to translate.***

INITIATIVE IS A GOOD THING. While trying to get back into the swing of things, I noticed that the JOLIBUSS INSTITUTE where I was teaching on Friday morns before I left was no longer occupied. Their building is right behind my place. I called Charles the Director and asked where had they gone? I was glad to have his number. He said they had relocated for they had out grown the old place. I think I called him on a Thursday and he was ready for me to speak on Friday. I could not at that time, but I said I would be ready next Friday. He said, "Ok." I was glad they had not moved to Kampala which is far away, but to a place called Majengo in which I could walk if I wanted to. I have been able to speak there 3 times already, and the place is huge in comparison to where they were. All new faces both students and staff. I speak to 80-100 people each Fri. It is a scary, but exciting feeling to be able to speak to people I have never seen before and am able to tell them the Glorious Gospel of Jesus Christ according to the Scriptures! ***Pray for salvation and growth of students and staff.***
