Sorry that my report letter is little bit delayed due to some preparations for our travel back to Sri Lanka. Last week also, the documents from Sri Lanka for our foundation that had been built three years ago has arrived and there are things to comply. This week in Sri Lanka is Hindu and Buddhist new year and next week they will review again our application and hopefully by the grace of God, the Lanka-Philippines Foundation will be approved. We already tried many ways so that we can stay longer in Sri Lanka and creating a foundation seems a better way for our situation.

I covet your prayers about this because this will be a blessing someday when someone being called by God to Sri Lanka and this foundation can be a tool as far as visa matter is concerned. It will be an additional burden also for us because we need financial budget for this because the Sri Lankan government will surely be monitoring us if we really function as it is. I don't have a missionary partner here since I am the only Filipino missionary in the whole country under ABC. Another burden also, is we have to rent an office, hire maybe two Sri Lankan workers, buy a second hand vehicle, etc. Because the basic function of this foundation is to give training and aid for the less fortunate people in Sri Lanka specially in the villages about fishing, farming and basic skills in construction such as plumbing, welding, electricity, masonry, carpentry, painting, etc. This would fit my professions as a license Civil Engineer and a License Master Plumber. We already spent much money for this because we hired a lawyer to facilitate on this matter.

Our church (God's Church) in Batticaloa is doing well. We hired a musician to teach our members organ and guitar; and most of our adult members and youth participated. We might growing very slow in number but they are growing a lot in their knowledge and personal walk with God.

Our church property that was donated by our member has been fenced and planted with few trees but our church money for the building is not yet enough even to start the building foundation but we are praying that we can start slowly this year by faith.

I seldom give report for our kids studies but let me give an update about them. My eldest daughter, Jellrose, who will be turning 19 on August will be 4th year in Med. Tech. this June. James, my eldest son will turn 17 this coming May will be in K11; Cherryrose who will turn 10 this June will be in grade 5 and our youngest, Josriel who will be turning 9 this June will be in grade 4. Cherryrose and Josriel will continue their home schooling in Sri Lanka.

Thank you once again for backing us up in your prayers and financial support. You are a part on every success in our ministry because we cannot do it without you behind us.
