Dear Missions Partners and Praying Friends,

Minimizing missions is belittling the great commission; belittling the great commission diminishes divine provision. Have a blessed new year to everyone!

2017 had a lot of trials, problems, and mixed emotions. After the rejection of our two applications for residence visa through NGO and through a business company, it ends up almost my imprisonment. They charged me of doing NGO work while in a tourist visa; which is against the Sri Lankan law. That is why we exit the country after three months of stay. This caused us again a of sacrifices from our financial budget. Surely, we have to win the lost at any cost! Beside all of these, we still believe that God's way is perfect because if we've been approved, still we have to go back to Philippines for my mother's death and burial on September. Another sad thing is three families quit serving the Lord but praise God He added another three that are more sincere!

While in Philippines, I was able to visit some of our faithful supporting churches who had not visited since our deputation. I had also a privileged to preach two Christian schools in Malabon that conducted an evangelistic meetings where more than 20 people received Christ as their Lord and personal saviour.

Our church in Sri Lanka is doing well. They were busy making an extension on the right side of our church building. We got permission from the house owner to cut one of the coconuts and one of the mango trees. This space was used during our Christmas fellowship and for future church special events.

Christmas in Sri Lanka is always a great opportunity to share the gospel message because during this season, they show some sort of respect for the Christians. Most of them won't reject if you give them gospel tracts. On the third week of December, many of our members participated to visit one of our outreaches (about 30Km away from our church). They gave gospel tracts and gifts to the kids and young people. Deacon Achcuthan was able to share the gospel message to this Hindu village. This village was a war zone area in 2009 and was occupied by Tamil tiger rebels.

Please continue to pray for our need. We have to prepare Php. 220,000.00 for our return back to our field and pray for these three candidates for baptism: Sis. Sangeetha. Bro. Pavithran and Bro. Jude Rajiv.
