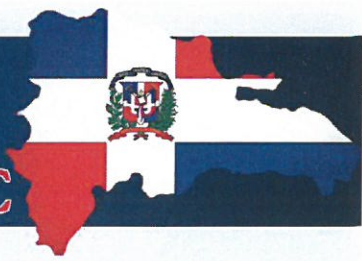

Dear Pastor and Co-laborer,

June 9, 2017

I hope this letter finds you doing well and enjoying the blessings of the Lord. As we wrote on our most recent prayer letter, our departure to the mission field is drawing nigh and we are so excited and can't wait to reach our people with the gospel of Jesus Christ.

We are thrilled that you have partnered with us to take the gospel to the Dominican Republic. We praise the Lord for your faithful prayers and financial support. Our prayer is that the Lord will continue to use you in your local area and around world in a great and mighty way.

We are so glad that throughout our deputation time, the Lord has allowed us to save sufficient funds to be able to take care of many of the expenses that we will have as we transition from the states to the mission field. By the grace of God, we've been able to save money for: our airfare, the purchase of a vehicle, appliances for our home in the DR, rental deposit for a house, expenses for shipping a container and certain utensils for the new church plant. We have also received some Bible tracks/Johns and Romans, baseball equipment (for our youth ministry) from supporting churches, and I am also currently working on getting 500 Spanish Bibles for our ministry.

We are writing this letter to ask you to pray that the Lord would provide for a special need that we have. Earlier this spring, we started the process for my wife, Pam, to become a Naturalized American Citizen. Becoming an American Citizen would give Pamela dual citizenship. This would help tremendously when we come back on furlough. For that reason, we have encountered some extra expenses such as: Lawyer for the case (due to the complexity of the case) and immigration fees. Because of the money that we had to spend on that, we now need money for customs when our container arrives in the DR. We are estimating the cost to be around four thousand dollars (48% of the value of items sent into the country).

Please pray with us about this need. If you feel led to help us with this need, please send to Account 1539, and mark it "Shipping and Customs for Polancos." We praise the Lord for you and for all that you have already done for us. Our target date of departure is August 1st.
