We are truly grateful for the opportunity to serve God on the mission field, and we are so thankful for you, our faithful co-laborers in the ministry. Our family is doing fine. I praise the Lord for my dear wife who is constantly beside me in the ministry and a tremendous blessing in our home. James, my boy, is now 18 and soon plans to get married to young girl of our church. My health has been a lot better and I praise the Lord for that. The Lord has opened many doors for us to preach missions conferences here in Brazil and I need good health to travel, this last week I was in a city 200 Km from Argentina preaching a revival.

The ministry that God has given to us in the city of Biguaçu in the metropolis of Florianopolis is going well. Please pray that we can reach the lost for Jesus Christ in this city, we have a tremendous amount of Pentecostal churches and the people here are very confused about what they believe. We have about 50 people which have been coming faithfully and we are praying that God will allow us to see many more people come to know Christ as their personal Savior. This last Sunday we baptized 3. This last month our church took a big leap in Faith Promise and we hope to be able to take on more missionaries, we support 16 missionaries and I am praying that soon we can reach 20 missionaries. I plan to start in the beginning of this following year, 2015 a Bible institute for our church, our greatest need in this state is for laborers and Lord willing we plan to train our own. We also plan this following year to start a new congregation in a city near by, please pray God will lead us to where to start this new church. Also I would like for your to pray, we have a special need to do some necessary work on our church, our church is in a poor area and the need is great, please consider helping us that we can raise the money necessary do the work we need on our church, I would like to raise 5,000 dollars for this project, if God should lead you to help us please send to BIMI and specify the offering to church.

Please pray that God will fill us with His Spirit and that we would have a greater compassion for lost souls. Again, thank you for faithful support for so many years.
