During this past year, God enabled me to make three trips to Papua New Guinea (PNG) with Brother Alan Brooks, assisting in the distribution of Bibles to the school students of PNG. Phase 1 was giving Bibles to all the high schools, secondary schools, colleges, and teacher training Institutes. It has been completed except for the areas where there are warring tribes. During our last visit in 2018 we launched Phase 2, which is distributing Bibles in the primary and middle schools. Phase 3 will be the elementary schools in the future as God supplies the funds to purchase the Bibles. Remember \$3 buys a Bible to be given free.

It is so exciting to preach the Gospel in so many schools to so many young people throughout the entire country, to see students that give their undivided attention whether indoors or outdoors, and to hear and see their gratitude when they are given their own Bible from the hands of one of our team members. The only regrettable thing is that Christine isn't able to travel with me to PNG due to the expense of traveling that far and the uncertainty of our accommodations while in the country. Of necessity we must move about a good bit, moving from region to region. So for now she is holding the ropes at home while I minister there. Please keep us both in your prayers as we continue assisting in this very worthy project. I am scheduled to return for the new school year with Brother Brooks on the 5th of February next year. There is much to prepare before then. I thank God for ARM ministries at BIMI.

Please pray for the Market Witness Ministry. It is my privilege to be part of this team witnessing for Christ in the States while I am not overseas. My soul winning partner, Brother Ralph Wiseman, continues faithful every week possible even in my absence. Between health problems with him and his wife, Rita, and very poor weather conditions to be outdoors, we have missed many days in the markets. If we have nice days, people will still come out to the markets, and we want to be there to witness and share Christ while we can.
