Here is the list of those needs

- We need to furnish the room.
- They need clothes.
- We need to buy a second van since the number of children we need to take to school increased to 27. We could purchase a 2012 van with about 70,000 miles for roughly 10,000 euro (11,000 usd)
- We need commitments from people that would like to touch their lives by providing food, clothing, access to education and healthcare through their monthly donations.
