Protests had been happening regularly already but they got a lot more intense as the elections got closer. Roads were closed due to damage (pictured), much of the transportation system was crippled, schools were closed for a week, etc. In our district of Tai Po, the train station and main freeway were closed for 3 days. We were literally trapped in our area. We had to cancel fellowships/services for that week and make sure we stocked up because stores were running out of things. After the elections, it was evident that the people of Hong Kong want democracy and freedom and will continue to fight for it.



We are thankful that things are somewhat back to normal now, though we are adapting to a new normal of riot police surrounding train stations and sporadic rallies happening across the city, as well as daily news filled with fires and protests. **Please continue to pray for Hong Kong that there will be a peace, safety, and a resolution very soon.**
