Re-Entry Expenses

Our first full-year furlough is coming to an end! There is a LOT of work and many expenses that are coming up in the next few weeks as we get ready to transition back to Thailand that we would like to share with you and ask you to pray about.

When we left for furlough we were not able to keep our house in Thailand, so the next few months will be very similar to our initial move and all of the setup expenses involved in that. On both sides of the world, there are a thousand things to do as we move out of our stateside home and arrive in Bangkok—without a home to move into.

Many of our supporters have encouraged us to share when we have a need, and this is one of those times. Would you pray about helping us? Here is just a sample of some of these costs coming up:

- Plane Tickets for a family of 5
- Temporary housing on arrival
- Rental deposits on a new place (usually 3-4 months worth in Thailand)
- Storage and Movers costs
- Extra Baggage fees
- Paperwork expenses
- Renovations, utility deposits, house set up,
- Stateside tying up of loose ends (Cancelling utilities, phones, car rental, etc.)

We estimate the total cost to be ~\$20,000.
