This year, her health has gone down; she decided to step down from teaching at age 74. She has a tumor in the lower part of her stomach and needs to have a surgery to take the tumor out and do biopsy but since we have social health care it takes time for every step. Her case is urgent. Noemi is losing weight rapidly. Please pray for her. We love her so much. It hurts us to see her in that situation. She loves the Lord, is a soul winner and loves serving the Lord.

Thank God for an amazing Bible Conference. Pastor Enoc Principe president of a Baptist Seminary in Peru, came with a group who will graduate this year. God’s precious Word touched our hearts, There were 4 people saved, and many decisions made for the glory of God.

Since we adopted Paul, several of you have followed updates about him. It is our joy to share another accomplishment in his life. It is amazing to watch Paul’s life, and how he has developed with God’s hand in his life he has overcome problems he had when we first brought him home at 6-1/2 years old. He had no language to communicate, very hyper, autistic, etc. This time after going to driving school interpreted by his mom, he had to study 600 questions for a test of 20. Thank God, he passed driving school then at DMV, they would not honor his appointment for the test because he does not hear well. We prayed as Paul prepared himself. A man wanted us to go through another route that did not please God. We told him, we were Christians and wanted to honor God doing the right thing for His glory. God answered our prayers. Paul was able to take his driving test and scored 18 out of 20. Praise the Lord. God is good. I am letting him drive in roads where there is not a lot of traffic to practice more and soon he will be driving in a lot of traffic. Guayaquil is a city of more than 3 million people. The driving here is crazy.

With grateful heart, we want to say thank you for joining us through prayer and giving to reach the deaf and hearing people. We are grateful for your effort. May the Lord supply your every need. It is our honor and privilege to serve our precious Savior.
