Their parents asked for help with Leo because he had not learned to read well nor basic math although he was a freshman in high school. All 3 students are being helped individually. Our precious son Paul is helping as an assistant to Leo's teacher, he works with Leo a lot. Praise God Leo received the Lord recently. Please help us keep the deaf school going.
