Greetings from Uganda! Thank you for your continued prayer and financial support.

Ministry & Praises:

These past few months have been a busy time in ministry. At the beginning of the year, we started praying that the Lord would allow us to move across town to be closer to Busaabala. The Lord allowed us to find a good house and we moved at the beginning of March. In the next few months, we will finish our Luganda studies and will be starting a midweek preaching point in Busaabala. A couple of Saturdays ago on our way out to go soul winning, we stopped by the new house for a quick moment. As we were about to leave, we began to share the gospel with the young man watching the property. Twenty minutes later Godfrey prayed and asked the Lord to save him. Praise the Lord! There is a new name written down in glory. At the beginning of this month, I started teaching one day a week in East Africa Baptist College. I am excited to be able to invest in the students' lives and help prepare them for full-time Christian ministry.

Family & Prayer Requests:

Please continue to pray for Jen, Patrick, Anson, Titus, and myself. Last month Jen started feeling like she had the flu, a couple of days passed and she only digressed. We went to the hospital, the doctor ordered labs and found that she had contracted a parasite called Bilharzia. Since then she has made a full recovery. This morning I took Patrick to the doctor because he was having the same symptoms and high fever. After the lab results came back, he too has contracted Bilharzia. Please continue to pray for his recovery. It is not an easy parasite to get rid of. As it dies and leaves the body the symptoms can be quite uncomfortable. Next week the rest of the family will go in for testing to make sure we all don't have the parasite.

Corona Virus in Uganda:

As of today, we do not have any confirmed cases in Uganda, Praise the Lord. The President has taken the necessary restrictions to keep it from entering and spreading. We have been given a thirty-two day time period of social restriction. We have been told all public venues have been canceled and that includes religious gatherings, schools, and public markets. In most public places there is either a hand washing station or hand sanitizer station with a watchful guard ensuring everyone is doing their part to stay healthy. It will be a challenge to see how we can proceed with church services in the next month. We know the Lord will provide and take care of our needs. With that, we have purchased the essentials and are preparing for the worst-case scenario while trusting the Lord.

We are praying for you all and thank you for praying for us as we navigate this situation with much prayer and anticipation for upcoming ministry opportunities.
