I recently read a synopsis of the martyrdom of missionaries John and Betty Stam at the hand of Chinese Communists in 1934. It is a moving account of both courage and faith. It's no wonder that their testimony had a far-reaching impact for the cause of Christ in China, as well as in the West. In fact, I remember my father telling me their story as a young child. One thing that I took away from the book is that a good testimony matters. Wherever we serve or whomever we are with—living out Scripture in daily life has great power to influence a lost world.

Recently we have seen believers use their testimony to bring other people to church. Andrew trusted Christ last year and has completed all 16 discipleship lessons. He met Veronique, a French lady in her late 40's, at our local market and invited her to our church. She commented to him that she had never been to a church even one time in her life! However, because of Andrew's good testimony, Veronique has visited the past several Sunday mornings and is beginning to read the Bible I gave her.

Esther, a Nigerian lady, professed her faith in Christ in March of this year and comes faithfully to services with her children. They live in a one-room apartment in a refugee complex that houses other asylum seekers and immigrants. She recently invited two ladies from the Congo, Huguette and Mariette, to join her at church. Since then, both ladies have been attending and are attentive to the message. It is interesting to note that these are not the first ladies who have come because of Esther's testimony, and I doubt they will be the last! A good testimony goes a long way.

Our children's class is growing! We recently held an activity where we visited our town's Christmas market and then stopped in at our home for a snack and some games. Please pray for the salvation of these children. Their hearts are tender.

With 2019 coming to an end, we give thanks to God for your faithfulness in supporting and praying for our family. We so appreciate the cards and messages that you send throughout the year, as well as at Christmas. It is a blessing to partner with you in reaching France.
