

Coolock is a suburb in the northeast of Dublin City. Approximately 22,232 people live here. It is in the middle of northeast Dublin which has a population of 150,000 people. In the past, this working class area has had a reputation of being a rough and dangerous place to live. Because of the cheaper housing there, a high proportion of the population is made up of young families. The whole northeast part of Dublin City does not have a single Baptist church.
