COVID-19...For a long time Uganda was without deaths, but as of the first week in July Uganda had their first death due to the virus. A woman had crossed over from Kenyan border not tested, got into Uganda that was infected and died as well as infected family. The borders were closed to travelers, except for truck drivers moving supplies. The truckers are allowed through once they have been tested and the results are negative. They get their certificate, and must go straight to their destination without stopping anywhere. 28 DEATHS DUE TO COV-19 AS OF AUG.

I again handed out the special 10 lessons to them because you do not need a Bible to do the courses. And, I gave each of them a New Testament and tracts.
