Dear Friends,

Yesterday in a short message to our church in Reynosa I preached a message on David and Goliath. How David killed Goliath with a sling shot but he did it in God's strength. I will quote one of my favorite verses. I am crucified with Christ nevertheless I live yet not I; but Christ liveth in me. And the life that I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the son of God who loved me and gave himself for me.

We started the Bethel Baptist Church by knocking on doors and winning people to the Lord. We had 150 in attendance before we organized. I sold my house in Mante and used part of the money to buy property and put up a building. Brother Antonio has been pastor since 2007. His youngest son has surrendered his life to be a missionary. His oldest son is still recovering from an injury sustained after a car ran over him and his right foot was crushed. The attendance has been an average of 135 and during the last three months 22 have been saved.

During the 80's and the 90's we spent one week of each month in Zactecas and for many years we saw many come to Christ. WE found a couple that surrendered their lives to the Lord. The names of this couple were Sergio and Gloria De Lira and they graduated in 1992 They returned to their city and established a church there. They continued in Zactecas from 1992 until 1999. Bro. Sergio resigned in 1999 and was called to pastor in Naranjos where he has remained. The picture in this letter is of them and is fairly recent. The other picture is one of their congregation. They have 3 children and all of them are serving the Lord. Their oldest son is dean of men in our Bible College. The church in Naranjos was having 90 in attendance until the covid 19 hit them. Their attendance now is 60. Recently they baptized six adults. Pray for this fine couple.
