Dear Friends,

We greet you in the lovely and wonderful name of Jesus Christ our living and loving Lord. We thank the Lord for His wonderful care over our lives for the year 2020. The Lord has provided our every need be it spiritual, physical or material and we are grateful.

About a month ago we started a prayer session every Friday from 10:00 am to 12 noon in our church. We called it "Jericho Hour." The idea was that we were going to pray and bring down our problems and troubles like Joshua and the Israelites brought down the walls at the instruction of the Lord. The results have been so encouraging and satisfying. Although many cannot come because of work; however, the few, about six, that come have been consistent, regular and committed and the Lord is doing some good things with us.

We felt that we needed to evangelize Kwabenya, a new and rising suburb about ten miles from our church. For the last two months we have been winning souls in this suburb. The Lord has given us about 20 converts. Now we have nowhere to gather them to pray, disciple and teach them the Word of God. The problem is that transportation to this place is mostly by motorcycle, popularly known as "okada." The women among these converts will not ride the "okada," neither are able to persuade the others to come to our main church being so far away.

We are now thinking and praying about buying a used bus. This bus will help us bring these new converts to our main church at Haatso where we are located. A used bus will cost us \$10,500. We have only \$525 in our church coffers. Another solution to this problem will be to purchase a plot of land to start a new church with these new converts. We have two capable deacons who will help to shepherd this new flock of believers.

On Wednesday, December 2, while visiting in the area, an elderly gentleman who is a landowner in the area offered to sell us a plot of land 100' x 70' at the cost of \$12,500. We don't have this amount of money, but we are asking the Lord to help us buy this property. We are also praying that if any of God's people would be interested to help us then we can have this property and start a new church in this suburb for the glory of God. Brethren, pray with us and for us that the Lord might provide these needs, namely, a used bus or a property of land so we can see the birth of a new church at Kwabenya, a suburb of Accra in Ghana, West Africa.

We thank you for your faithful support over the years and we wish you a merry Christmas and a happy new year.
