Dear Family and Friends,

Thank you for your prayers and support. Over the past two years, I have been amazed as God has continued to add new partners. I am beyond grateful to have each of you praying for me and could not do it without your support.

I have some exciting news! I am now approaching the final goal of 100% monthly support and have transitioned into my full-time role as a staff nurse of the RSC at Medical Missions Outreach. Over the past 4 months, I have assisted in the planning, execution, and follow-up for two teams made up of 32 medical professionals. These teams were able to provide no-cost surgical procedures to 57 patients, each of whom heard the gospel and received follow-up from our local church partners at Iglesia Bautista El Faro.

Below is one of our patient's stories.

On October 15, 2022, a local taxi driver named Erin was hit in a head-on collision. The hospital notified us the next day that Erin suffered from an oblique fracture and needed surgery. On October 19th we were able to provide Erin with the required surgery. It is amazing because we struggled to acquire orthopedic cases before our arrival. However, God knew ahead of time that Erin would need surgery and made sure we were there with the necessary equipment, and also had time and staff available. Seeing Erin begin in excruciating pain, assisting in his surgery, and finally seeing him post-op with no more pain was priceless. Please pray that Erin will come to know the Lord through this trial.

I have accepted a new leadership role at the surgical center, helping to run point on all travel team preparations and organization. This extra responsibility requires me to spend time in both our home office in McDonough, Georgia during the preparation phase, and in Honduras to plan, host, and follow up for each surgical team.

We have learned so much over the past few months as I have been able to serve in my new role. This time has been a TREMENDOUS growing experience, with the Lord patiently stretching me mentally, physically, and spiritually. I could not have done it without your prayers.

I am so excited to finally be able to serve full-time in this way and cannot wait to see what God has in store. It is encouraging to see all the positive changes that have already occurred.

There are currently 5 teams scheduled this year! We are excited to have an OBGYN coming in April. As we continue to grow and add more teams, our needs list is continually developing.
