**Progress at the Kokura church:** Three projects have been completed at the Kokura church. First, on the last Sunday of August the Kokura church had the first meal in our new Fellowship Hall. Third, the church purchased a cemetery plot. Many cemeteries in Japan are controlled by the temples and shrines, but we were able to find a plot in a private cemetery.
