Vacation Bible School

The weeks before August, we were busy inviting kids to our VBS and making sure that we had the things we needed for the event. VBS was a wonderful week. We started with 48 in attendance on our first day and nine professions of faith, then had a total of 120 in our very last day (twelve of which were parents attending for the first time), and we had over 40 professions of faith in our very last night. That weekend continued with activities related to VBS, including a teen activity and a special award ceremony Sunday night which brought our highest attendance of an evening service with 58. The total profession of faith during that week was 69. Glory be to God for those souls that decided to trust Him.



I would also love to share that during the month of August, we had two special visits that made our VBS possible: Missionary John Tinkle, (whose family is joining us in our efforts to reach this town for Christ), and a supporting church of ours-Salisbury Baptist Temple. There are not enough words to say

how they were such a blessing to us and our ministry. I am sure we were not going to be able to accomplish what we did without them here.
