



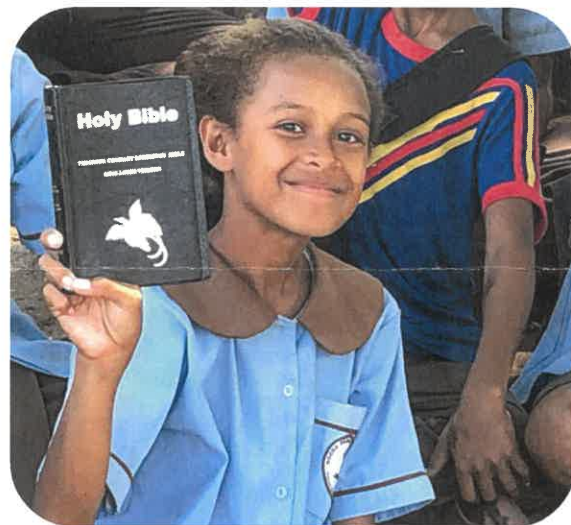
# Mickey & Christine Schrimshire
