Brother Duarte felt led of the Lord to take the work in El Paraiso, the city near us that is located just minutes from the Nicaraguan border. Student Outreach Results

We had the privilege of visiting two villages just outside of Danli, accompanying Manna Water for Life as they drilled for water in these areas where there is limited access to potable water. While the technicians drilled for water, our seminary staff and students were given access to the public schools to preach the Gospel! Many made decisions for Christ. After the schools let out for the day, we divided into groups and went house to house sharing the Gospel and giving needy families water filters to help them gain access to clean water.
