## Prelude

As we shared earlier, we had to remodel the inside of our auditorium at the beginning of the year to provide for more seating. Since we finished the remodel in February, the auditorium has been full every Sunday with record attendances in recent weeks. We have had visitors every week and definitely see the Lord working in lives. The spirit in the church is positive and encouraging and our people are doing a fantastic job with bridging the language barriers. We continue to minister in Romanian, English, Russian/Ukrainian, and German in each service through translation, as well as having both Romanian and Ukrainian Sunday school classes for the children and teens. There are activities and services on the church property almost every day of the week, and though this is exciting, it also brings with it many challenges.

Since the war in Ukraine is continuing, many of the Ukrainian families that moved into Timisoara have begun to establish themselves permanently here. Therefore, we are no longer looking at this shift (addition) in ministry as temporary. We feel that our church will continue to have a multinational ministry, and we are planning for the future with this in mind. We are currently praying about the need to have a Ukrainian adult Sunday school class, This would necessitate the purchase of a couple containers to create another meeting room on the property. This meeting room would also be available for activities and Bible studies throughout the week. God has already blessed us with the space on the property for this, we just need the funds to purchase the containers. Pray that God would meet this need soon.

Ladies'/Men's Ministry: In the last few months, we were able to have several Ladies' Nights that were used for outreach to both Romanian and Ukrainian ladies. We have a time of fellowship, games, a craft, a challenge from the Word of God and of course, food. Each Ladies Night, we have had visitors, and have seen God lead in ways that challenge and encourage ladies in their walk with the Lord. Alongside ministry to our ladies, we have had Men's breakfasts and a Men's barbeque to encourage our men to be Godly husbands, fathers, and leaders. We have taken a short break during the summer months, but please pray as plans are being made to begin again in September.

There were 5 teens saved and other decisions made that will last for eternity! In August we are holding our first Men and Boys campout. We are hoping that this will be a strengthening time for our men as well as a great time of fellowship!
