Dear Friends,

Every July, we, as Americans, celebrate the day our nation declared independence from Great Britain, and obtained freedom for all American people. Having been born in The United States of America, I was granted national liberty upon birth. I am forever grateful for this privilege; however, though I was born physically free, spiritually, I was born into slavery. As sinners, we were all born into bondage, chained to our sinful nature with no hope. Then Christ came and gave us hope! In Luke 4:18, Christ informs us, "The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised..." He has not gotten saved yet, but he has been faithfully coming to church and talking with me about the Scriptures. Please pray for this young man to surrender his life to Christ. Christ is the only one who can make us free!

We recently got to see Tabitha's family for a couple days. We met with them while we were in Port Moresby. It was a blessing being able to spend time with them. Tabitha's younger sisters had not yet met Cassia, so they were very excited to hold their niece for the first time!

July marked our two-year wedding anniversary. God has blessed us abundantly these two years. He gave us a beautiful baby girl, He gave us so many amazing experiences during our deputation, He supplied for our every need, and He enabled us to move to Papua New Guinea to do our part of the Great Commission.

Thank you all for your faithful support of the Wilson family. Please continue to pray for the people of Kerema. The Lord has blessed us with many opportunities to tell these people of the true gospel of Christ. Please pray for them receive Him as their Saviour, for He alone can make us free!
