Dear Friends,

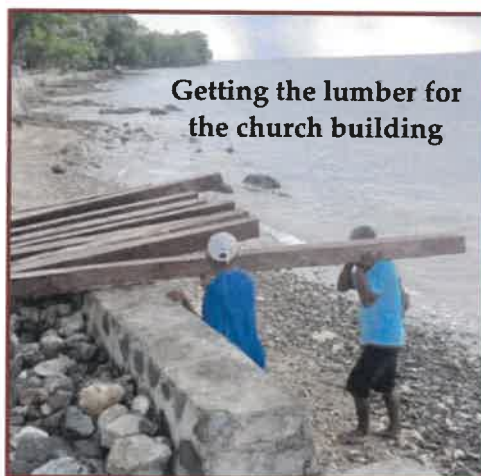

We then went to America for a few weeks to attend to our family, and get some ministry supplies. We are now back in Papua New Guinea. We are thankful that God allows us to do, and we are thankful for all of the people who help us accomplish our work for Christ!
